



8.4.3 Supplier PO Terms and Conditions

AFORGE Supplier Requirements:

1. Supplier is required to notify AFORGE of any process or product changes that could affect form, fit, function, dimensional characteristics, durability or appearance.
2. AFORGE, our customers, and regulatory authorities have access to suppliers, and relevant sub-tier suppliers, facilities and records as applicable for inspection of deliverables of purchase orders from AFORGE.
3. Supplier is responsible for control of AFORGE customer proprietary documents and controlled use items.
4. Supplier shall retain documentation of quality records (legible, identifiable, retrievable, in English) for a period of 5 years.
5. Suppliers are responsible for training/certification of personnel performing work that affects product quality.
6. Suppliers must maintain traceability of product and material throughout production.
7. Nonconforming products must be identified and AFORGE to be notified. CAR's will be issued for nonconformances.
8. Material test reports required when applicable.
9. Supplier shall pack to preserve and protect against damage, degradation, and loss during shipment.
10. Counterfeit parts prevention required.
11. Supplier shall flow down to sub-tier suppliers all applicable requirements.
12. Ensure people are aware of their contribution to product and service conformity, their contribution to product safety and importance of ethical behavior
